Subject: Update Regulations Governing Transfers

Dear Sir or Madam,

We take reference to the decision of the EHF Executive Committee regarding the Regulations for Transfers between Federations and in particular for the transfer fees exchange rate.

All international transfers are subject of the IHF basic documents approved in the period 2-5 May 2011 at the IHF Congress in Marrakesh / Morocco: IHF Player Eligibility Code and IHF Regulations for Transfer between Federations - effective as of 1 July 2011. It is to be noted that the transfer fees decided by the IHF Congress, to be used for all transfers, were fixed in Swiss Francs. The Euro is the official currency of the EHF and most of its Member Federations, and within the Euro Zone bank transfers are in principle free of charge. In order to avoid additional expenses for all involved, the EHF Executive decided to use the CHF amount specified converted into EUR. On 16 September 2016, at the meeting of the EHF Executive Committee in Reykjavik an update of the transfer fees exchange rate was agreed. Taking a pragmatic view of the situation and considering the competition season framework, national federations/clubs budgeting, current transfer procedure, etc. it is useful to link the yearly update to the corresponding competing season as of 1 July – 30 June. Therefore, following the above-mentioned decision we ask you to take note of the following:

All the transfer requests for **amateur** and **professional players**, addressed prior and including 30 June 2021, are subject to the previous fees of EUR 140 respectively EUR 1420 (EHF + releasing national federation). Concerning the education compensation, same principle applies, prior and including 30 June 2021: NT/national federations - EUR 1420 and clubs - EUR 3.315.

All the transfer requests for **amateur** and **professional players**, addressed on 1 July 2021 and thereafter, are subject to the updated fees as of EUR 140 respectively EUR 1360 (EHF + releasing national federation). Concerning the education compensation, for transfers addressed on 1 July 2021 and thereafter: NT/national federation – EUR 1360 and clubs – EUR 3.180. For education compensation amateurs – clubs (**NEW!**) (please refer to the attached European Nations Ranking) following amounts are related to the respective ranking: € 500 / € 910 / € 1360.

You are kindly asked to take note; we thank you for your understanding and cooperation in this matter.
